- Recently some instances of fraudsters attempting to dupe Indian Nationals
 residing in Indonesia by impersonating as officers of the Embassy have come
 our notice. Invariably, they make these fraudulent calls by spoofing the phone
 number of the Embassy.
- These fraudsters intimate the unsuspecting victim about some wrong or inadequate information in his/her passport or immigration records and threaten with possible case against them or deportation. They demand a fine or penalty to be paid through private money transfers.
- Indian nationals who receive such fraudulent calls are requested to please send the details by email at cons.jakarta@mea.gov.in in the format given below.
- It is reiterated that Embassy does not call people to ask for money, etc, and hence such calls must be ignored and reported immediately.
